

How Seduction Destroys Marriages

The word “seduction” comes from the root word “seduce,” and the word “seduce” comes from the Latin word “sēdūcēre.” To seduce means to “lead astray.”

But, how is it that a word that was originally used to describe the evil acts of a person is now welcomed, even in the church? Searching throughout the scriptures, the word “seduce” was never used to describe a holy or acceptable act, but instead, represented a charming or enticing of the flesh to aid the seducer in accomplishing an evil purpose.

Nevertheless, with the 21st century's obsession with fornication and everything sexual, it is no wonder how seduction made its way into the marriage scene and eventually into many Christian homes. The popular belief nowadays is that the more you seduce a man and the more you know your way around a bedroom; the more likely he is to marry you and to stay with you. After all, this is what society projects on the television screen, leaving many women to use seduction and other forms of witchcraft in an attempt to become his wife and to remain his wife. However, this is not true in many cases as most men are able to separate love from lust in their hearts, whereas, the average woman cannot. And in those rare cases where a man does marry a woman because she is sexually charged, the marriage usually ends either because he got bored and begin to search outside of the home or because, well, she was so sexually charged that she was burning out some of her battery life on another person.

Nowadays, modern-day Christianity openly welcomes seduction as long as it stays between a man and his wife. Ask yourself this question. If you bought a snake into your home and dressed it like a little boy, would he act as your son? What if you fed it, took it to church with you, disciplined it and gave it a good-night kiss before bedtime? Would it not still bite you?

The same goes for seduction. If you bring a wile of the devil into your home, will it not entice everyone in your home into sin?

Again, the word “seduce,” explains the evil acts of a person towards another person for gain. To seduce also means “to entice.” In searching the scriptures, you will not find the word “entice” associated with holy matrimony either. In Proverbs 1:10, God warns HIS children and commands us not to be enticed by sinners into sin. In 2 Chronicles 18:19, God asked the spirits, who would be willing to go forward and entice Ahab to go up against Ramoth-Gilead so that he may be destroyed. Of course, if you know the story, a spirit came forward and volunteered to entice Ahab by being a lying spirit in the mouth of his prophets. In the book of Judges, the story of Samson and Delilah displays how the Philistines instructed Delilah to go home and entice Samson, so they could learn the secret of his strength. And the list goes on and on.

Seduction, obviously, is a form of manipulation and we all know that manipulation is witchcraft. Again,

why are we bringing this into our marriages? Christian divorces are so common nowadays that the church simply shrugs its shoulders at it and doesn't take a stand against it. Instead, divorce is now seen as an option, when it was never intended to be that way. One of the biggest uncovered reasons is because the average Christian home invites demons in from lack of knowledge! Most people don't know that seduction is witchcraft! Again, seduction means to lead astray!!! Look at that definition! That, in itself, tells you a lot about what you are doing when you go home and try to seduce your husband/wife! You are leading them astray. When you seduce your husband, you are leading him into the arms of another woman (or possibly another man these days) who will seduce him even more.

And then there are the Christians who desire to be married, but don't have many great teachers around that could offer them sound and wise counsel. They have leaders who can offer them wise pointers, but when it comes to the challenges of marriage and the truths about the different types of spirits that invade marriages, they themselves are in the dark. I have heard and seen some ministers telling women to basically be more perverse! And then some of those same ministers have to comfort these souls as they go through the pangs of an affair. And get this! When an affair takes place, the leaders that told the wives to be more perverse are sometimes the first ones to suggest divorce!!! They are teaching these hungry souls how to seduce their husbands!!! And these jewels go into marriages believing that they need to seduce their mates by bringing into their homes, all manners of evil such as sex toys, videos and so on. These homes are full of devils!

Tomorrow's brides are trying to learn how to be 'kinkier' so that their husbands will be well pleased with their bedroom activity. Tomorrow's groomsmen are being taught to let their guards down against this spirit; therefore, rather than being the strongman of the house, he learns to open his door to all forms of devils. "Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first bind the strong man? and then he will spoil his house." (Matthew 12:29) His wife binds him with handcuffs, not understanding that she is mirroring what is happening to him in the spirit! He is being bound by devils who will rape him and spoil his home.

Ladies, when you bring seduction into your marriage, you are in the same bringing every spirit that is affiliated with seduction into your home. It is no wonder that the majority of Christian husbands that have succumbed to adultery were originally weakened by seduction at home. Never ever think a spirit will visit you only in the hour that you want it to, but will go away from you when it's not needed. When a devil invests stock into your marriage, it plans to collect on its investment! Your marriage bed is supposed to be undefiled!

And I know that a lot of you that are married have found your husbands to be perverse. So, you find yourself going to great lengths to appease his desires, but understand this: What is in him or attached to him is unholy and demonic. A demon has the belly of hell, meaning it is never satisfied. A demon's mission is to gather as many souls as it can. A demon knows and understands how a soul tie works.

Every time a man lays down with a woman, he makes a deposit into her. When that woman is his God-given wife (covenant) and he is in the will of God, the deposit is holy and uncontaminated. But, when a man goes from under the order (Christ is the head of man), he uncovers his head to witchcraft and as such, his soul becomes defiled or contaminated with things unholy. Therefore, when he lays with a woman, his deposit is contaminated and unholy and he becomes her misled husband. This is why an adulterous man has trouble being with one woman or two for that matter! He is like a demon's convenience store; he's always open. Because what is in him desires that he make unholy deposits in as many women as he can. He is never satisfied for long because that demon in or attached to him cannot be filled!

This means that what you are trying to satisfy in him is of an evil nature. Rather than trying to appease what is in him, you need to pray and fast that thing out and off of him. Many women that have been victims of an adulterous husband will tell you that they went to great lengths to satisfy their husbands and keep them satisfied, nevertheless, he still strayed. What went wrong? They didn't understand that they were feeding a demon and it was growing and gaining more power as they fed it. You can't destroy a demon with a demon.

But, you're probably thinking by now that I'm suggesting you have a lifeless marriage sexually. Quite the contrary! You can have one of the most intensifying marriages in and outside of the bedroom without the use of tools, gadgets and seduction! When God is in the marriage, that stuff isn't needed! You don't have to 'set the mood,' when love is around. Any happily married woman of God will tell you, all it takes is a "hello" or a smile! No, there is nothing wrong with wearing lingerie for your husband when your motives are right and the lingerie is not designed for role playing. You are who you are and he is to love you like that. But, when you have to be another woman to 'turn him on,' it's time for a fast. Wearing lingerie is no different than wearing makeup or nice clothing, since you are doing so to look visually appealing to him. But, when you wear lingerie in an attempt to gain something, then it is used as a tool of seduction because there is a motive behind it. While many are snubbing and thinking that marriage without seduction is boring, there are men and women who have been happily married for over 50 years and they have never used all of those tools and tactics that are nowadays laying with Christians in their marriage beds. So, while they snub, the men and women of God that have discovered this truth have the most fulfilling marriages because they were stimulated by love from the inside.

You want to be married until death do you part and not until another woman does you apart? Don't learn to be seductive, learn to be wise. Find any couple that has been married the amount of years that you want and ask them yourself. Wisdom will take your marriage to whole new heights that you didn't even know existed! Perversion and seduction burn the man up and it is snuffed out in a moment's time, but wisdom, knowledge and understanding will keep him lit and that is a fire that will never be

extinguished.
